Parents, Mark Your Calendars: Totus Tuus Summer Catechism will be held July 22-27 this summer! 1st-8th grades will meet Monday-Friday (9 am – 3 pm), High School students will meet Sunday-Thursday (8-10 pm). TOTUS TUUS (Latin for "Totally Yours" Jesus, through Mary) is a summer Catholic catechetical program dedicated to the youth in order to evangelize and teach the faith of the Church. The aim is to help all youth develop their relationship with Jesus Christ so that there is an intimate friendship whereby He may lead them to the Father in the Holy Spirit. The program calls upon college students and seminarians to carry out this mission. Teams of four (two men and two women) go into a parish for one week during the summer, putting on a "parish mission" in order to teach the faith and inspire the youth. **Youth from Sacred Heart Church in Crete will be joining us this year!**
