**Our 2018 Mission Cooperatiave Appeal** will be conducted by Fr. Raj from the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India the weekend of July 28-29 to speak about their missionary activities and challenges. The diocese has certain concrete and meaningful goals which include: 1) Establishing 10 more new parishes, each with a new church and rectory; 2) Providing the 126 Catholic schools in the missions with better facilities and catechetical materials; 3) Enabling 485 nuns and 2155 Catholic Teachers in charge of catechetical, educational, medical and social ministries throughout the diocese to educate the children in the Catholic faith; 4) Providing buildings to the mission schools in villages (the government pays most of the teachers); 5) Education of more young men in the seminary; and 6) Education of 1000 very poor or orphan children from poor families by providing them free room and board. All of these mission projects are 80% dependent on Mission Appeal funds. The diocese is trying to materialize these missionary goals, depending on the availability of funds. 60% of Catholics in the Kumbakonam diocese are depressingly poor. Your fervent prayers and generous help are earnestly requested.
