A message from our Chancery: Scammers are targeting our diocese, parishes and schools. There have been multiple reports from parishes and from other diocesan entities that a large number of priests are being impersonated by scammers trying to convince parishioners to send them gift cards. These scammers have been pulling priest and parishioner information off of parish or school websites and using it to impersonate the priest's email address and send out emails requesting gift card numbers. When phone numbers have been available, phony texts have been reported, too. Please be aware of these types of attacks. Always confirm with the source directly in person, by mail or by phone. Don't reply to odd sounding emails because scammers would receive the information also.
