**At the most recent St Wenceslaus Parish Council meeting** it was approved to raise the suggested offering for big vigil lights to \$4.00 each and small vigil lights to \$1.00 each. A vigil light represents the place of the person asking intercession for prayer intentions for the length of the candle life, not a candle per intention.
