Please join us Wednesday, September 11 for Region V QPR training. This training will take place at 6:30 pm in the Wilber-Clatonia High School Auditorium. Question, Persuade, and Refer is a nationally recognized suicide prevention program. Research has shown that if someone is asked the Question when experiencing a suicidal crisis, the risk is reduced by 90%. Please join us in learning how to ask the Question.
