PRO LIFE NOVENA: In the Catholic Church, a 'novena' consists of prayers or actions over nine successive days beginning January 19th. *9 Days for Life* pro-life novena is an opportunity for recollection and reparation in observation of the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*—the Supreme Court decision that made abortion legal throughout the United States. Sponsored by the Committee on Pro-Life Activities of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, *9 Days for Life* began in 2013 in commemoration of the 40th anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision. This is the tenth year the novena is taking place. The overarching intention of the novena is the end to abortion. Each daily intention highlights a related topic and is accompanied by a reflection, educational information, and suggested daily actions. The novena encompasses the annual [Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children](#) on January 22. All are invited to sign up at 9daysforlife.com. Participants can receive the novena in English or Spanish via email or text message or access it online.
